St. Stephen's Religious Ed/Baptism

Please plan to attend three classes if you wish your child to be baptized. Next classes will be in October on 10/1, 10/8 & 10/15 @ 5:30pm.

Registration for Religious Education for K-8 students will be on Sunday, September 30th after the 9am Mass. Classes for K-8 grades begin on Sunday, October 7th after the 9am Mass.

Students who want to receive First Holy Communion must be in at least the 2nd grade and attend class each week until May.

Students who wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation must be in at least the 7th grade and attend class each week until May.

Adults who wish to be baptized or confirmed are invited to join class starting on Tuesday, October 9th (5:30am-7pm) at St. Stephens or Thursday, October 11th (5:30pm-7pm) at St. Joseph's. This will be a weekly class that runs until Easter.
