 Adults who wish to be baptized or confirmed are invited to join class starting on Tuesday, October 9th (5:30pm-7pm) at St. Stephens or Thursday, October 11th (5:30pm-7pm) at St. Joseph's. This will be a weekly class that runs until Easter.
