### JustFaith Catholic

How are we being called to address poverty?

Faith and Poverty: A Biblical Response, part of the JustFaith Catholic series, explores God's call to respond to poverty in our local communities, equipping participants to take action in effective and sustainable ways.

In this program, participants explore these two questions:

1. What tools does my Catholic faith have to offer regarding huge questions around poverty and injustice.
2. In light of poverty and other forms of human suffering, what is the Good News of the Gospel? Participants will emerge from this program with a transformed understanding of who they are as God's child and how God is calling them to use their lives.

We will be offering Faith and Poverty: A Biblical Response at St. Stephens beginning Wednesday March 23, 2022. The program will meet for 8 weeks on Wednesdays from about 6pm to 8:30pm right here at St. Stephens. There is a retreat and immersion experience involved as well for those who can attend. A printable version of the survey will also be available when the link is provided. Information where to submit paper copies will be provided later.
