**The Institutional Dimensions of the Abuse Crisis in the Catholic Church**

A Zoom Presentation for Victim/Survivors of Clergy Sexual Abuse and Those Who Accompany Them on Their Journey

This presentation will address what is specific to the Catholic Church in the phenomenon of abuse (sexual and not only): clericalism but also a system of power that is very structured - priests, bishops, the pope vis-a-vis a laity that tends to be not structured and not organized. Some of these unique Catholic features are root causes of the phenomenon of abuse, but some Catholic specificities can also be seen as resources for solutions to the problem.



Dr. Massimo Faggioli is a full professor in the department of theology and religious studies at Villanova University. He received his PhD in Religious History from the University of Turin in 2002. He later continued his studies on the Second Vatican Council at the renowned institute of "Giovanni XXIII" for Religious Studies in Bologna, Italy. His areas of expertise include the papacy, Vatican II, the Roman Curia, liturgical reform, Massimo

Faggioli's new Catholic movements, and Catholicism and global politics. He is a contributing writer for Commonweal and a columnist for La Croix International.

"I invite everyone to make this coming 2nd March, Ash Wednesday, a Day of Fasting for Peace: let believers dedicate themselves intensively to prayer and fasting. May the Queen of Peace preserve the world from the madness of war." *Pope Francis*

### Here are the Church regulations for fasting and abstinence during Lent:

- Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.
- Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.



Lent begins this Wednesday. Mass with distribution of ashes will be at 9am and 5pm at St. Stephens.

During the Fridays of Lent the Stations of the Cross will be held after the 5pm Mass.
