Church Regulations for fasting and abstinence during Lent

*Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and on Good Friday.

*Everyone 18 or older, and 59 years of age, is bound fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

*On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals in not permitted. When health or ability to would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

*Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these minimal penitential practices.

(A Lenten question that is frequently asked: is chicken meat? Yes, chicken is meat)
